Today is the Fourth Sunday in Lent

The third, fourth, and fifth Sundays in Lent are historically times to give particular emphasis during public worship to the primary Lenten work of forming persons for baptism or reaffirmation of faith. In the early church, prayers during worship on these Sundays included acts of exorcism as they prayed for what Wesley would call deliverance from “natural tempers” and the growth of “spiritual tempers” in the desires, affections, and inner lives of the candidates.

We have a wonderful opportunity to engage in this “exorcism” / “examen” / “examination of conscience” / self-examination today, as we heard the word of God proclaimed and prepare for the taking of communion.
