

Message #1 of 3 - Encouraged By The Word

"Just Say The Word"

Everybody has faith in something.

Are you putting your faith in the One who is rock solid?

Luke 7:1-10 (Matthew 8:5-13) February 7, 2016

1. FAITH – Luke 7:4, 7, 9

• Pharisees: "They pleaded earnestly." - v.4

• Centurion: "Just say the word." - v.7

• Jesus: "Such great faith." - v.9

2. THE PHARISEES' FAITH - Luke 7:4-5

When they came to Jesus, they pleaded earnestly with him, "This man deserves to have you do this, because he loves our nation and has built our synagogue."

3. THE CENTURION'S FAITH - Luke 7:6-7

"Lord, don't trouble yourself, for I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. That is why I did not even consider myself worthy to come to you. But say the word, and my servant will be healed."

4. A STRONG WARNING ABOUT FAITH – Matthew 8:11-12

"I say to you that many will come from the east and the west, and will take their places at the feast with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven. But the subjects of the kingdom will be thrown outside, into the darkness, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."

1st Timothy 1:15-16

Here is a <u>trustworthy</u> saying that deserves full acceptance:

Christ Jesus came into <u>the world</u> to save <u>sinners</u>—

of whom I am the worst.

But for that very reason I was shown mercy
so that in me,
the worst of <u>sinners</u>,

Christ Jesus might display his unlimited patience
as an example for those who would believe on him
and receive eternal life.

"Preach the gospel daily to yourself. We need to hear the gospel everyday because we forget it everyday." - Martin Luther

- Religion is ... I obey God, therefore I am accepted.
- The Gospel is ... I'm accepted through what Jesus Christ has done, therefore I obey.
- Religion is ... Jesus is a teacher because I follow Jesus' teaching God has to bless me.
- The Gospel is ... Jesus is a savior, a mighty one; only because of what He has done am I saved by grace.

Question: What is your only comfort, in life and in death?

Answer: That I belong—body and soul, in life and in death—not to myself but to my faithful Savior, Jesus Christ, who at the cost of his own blood has fully paid for all my sins and has completely freed me from the dominion of the devil; that he protects me so well that without the will of my Father in heaven not a hair can fall from my head; indeed, that everything must fit his purpose for my salvation. Therefore, by his Holy Spirit, he also assures me of eternal life, and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for him.
