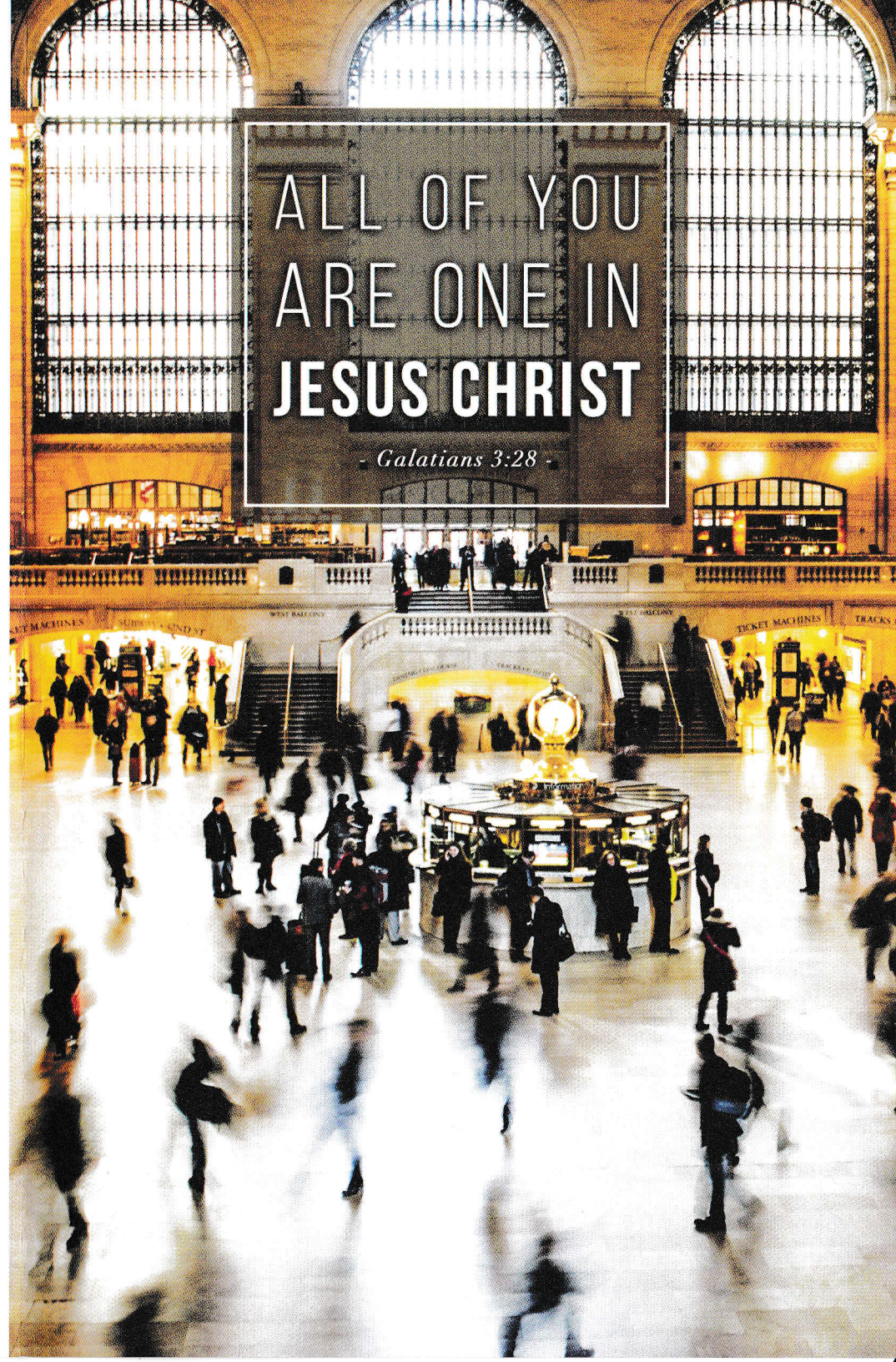

*Transferring your basic, foundational ‘life trusts’
from your moral virtue, to Jesus’ virtue.*

Luke 7:1-10

June 19, 2015 – Father’s Day

KEY PLAYERS:

A – A Centurion: *“I don’t deserve it.”*

B – Friends: *“He does deserve it.”*

C – The Servant: *“Is sick and about to die.”*

D – Jesus: *“Amazed at such great faith.”*

1. VALUE HIGHLY – (v.2, 3)

- *“There was a centurion’s servant whom his master **valued highly.**” – v.2*
- *“Come and heal his servant.” – v.3*

2. PLEAD EARNESTLY – (v. 2, 4)

- *“they came to Jesus and **pleaded earnestly** with him.” – v.4*

3. GO WILLINGLY – (v.3, 6, 10)

- *“The centurion ... sent **some elders** of the Jews to Jesus.” – v.3*
- *“The centurion sent **friends** to say to Jesus.” – v.6*
- *“**The men who** had been sent returned.” – v.10*

4. HEAL READILY – (v.3, 7, 10)

- *“Come and **heal** his servant.” – v.3*
- *“Say the word & my servant **will be healed.**” – v.7*
- *“And found the servant **well.**” – v.10*

ACTION PLAN:

1. **Look** at the people around you
2. **Acknowledge** them
3. **Talk** with them
4. **Begin** a spiritual conversation
5. **Share** your story
