1. A PIT: Can a Blind Man Lead a Blind Man?

(Luke 6:39-40)

*A student is not above **his** teacher,
but **everyone who** is fully trained will be like **his** teacher.*

“STUDENT” –

μαθητῆ *mathētēs* 261 times in the New Testament

A disciple,

A learner

A follower

“FULLY TRAINED” –

καταρτιζω *katartizō*

- *to adjust thoroughly;*
- *to knit together,*
- *unite completely,*
- **to qualify fully,**
- **to complete** in character,

Psalms 82:5

2nd Corinthians 4:4

Matthew 23:13

→ *Who are you following?*

2. A SPECK: How Can You Say to Your Brother?

(Luke 6:41-42)

*You **hypocrite**, first take the plank out of **your** eye,
and then **you** will see clearly
to remove the speck from **your brother's** eye.*

Matthew 23:25

→ *Are you looking at your own life or someone else’s life?*

3. A TREE: Does a Good Tree produce Bad Fruit?

(Luke 6:43-44)

*For out of the overflow of **his** heart
his mouth speaks.*

→ *What is the overflow of your heart?*
