1. DON’T EXPLOIT YOUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

(Luke 4:3-4)

“Jesus said, It is written:

‘Man does not live on bread alone.’”

2. DON’T DEPRIVE GOD OF WORSHIP

(Luke 4:5-8)

“Jesus said, It is written:

‘Worship the Lord your God and serve him only.’”

3. DON’T DO WHATEVER YOU WANT OR CAN

(Luke 4:9-12)

“Jesus said, It is written:

‘Do not put the Lord your God to the test.’”
