"THE PROBLEM OF DOUBTS"

God uses difficult times to turn our doubts into faith, peace, and forgiveness through the power of the Holy Spirit.

John 20:1-31

February 17, 2019

1. DOUBTING -

- "While it was still <u>dark</u>." v.1
- *"Went to the tomb."* v.1
- "They have <u>taken the Lord</u> out of the tomb." v.2
- "Peter & John ran to the tomb." v.3, 4
- "The strips of linen were lying there, as well as the burial cloth." 6, 7
- "Mary stood outside the tomb <u>crying</u>." v.11
- "They have <u>taken my Lord away</u>." v.13
- "The disciples were together, with the doors locked, for fear." v.19

2. KNOWING -

- "We <u>don't know</u> where they have put him!" v.2
- "They <u>did not understand</u> from Scripture that Jesus had to rise from the dead." v.9
- "I don't know where they have put him." v.14
- "She <u>did not realize</u> it was Jesus." v.14

God is bigger than: your past, your pain, your fear, your scars, your hate, your doubt, this world.

3. SEEING -

- "Mary <u>saw</u> that the stone had been removed from the entrance." v.1
- "John look in at the strips of linen lying there." v.5
- "Peter <u>saw</u> the strips of linen lying there." v.6
- "Mary <u>looked</u> into the tomb and <u>saw</u> two angels." v.11b-12a
- "Mary <u>saw</u> Jesus standing there." v.14
- "I have seen the Lord!" v.18
- "The disciples were overjoyed when they <u>saw</u> the Lord." v.20
- "We have seen the Lord!" v.25
- "Unless I <u>see</u> and feel the nail marks, I won't believe it." v.25
- "Put your finger here; <u>see</u> my hands." v.27

4. BELIEVING -

- "John saw and believed." v.8
- "Stop doubting and <u>believe</u>." v.27b
- "You believe because you have seen." v.29a
- "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet <u>believe</u>." v.29b
