"OUR FEARS & GOD'S WORK"

We often fear the worst, but God is always working in, through, and around us for the best. Matthew 2:16-21 January 12, 2020 / Communion Sunday

1. <u>DEATH</u> – *OUT-WITTED* (v.16)

"Herod ... was furious, and gave orders to kill ..."

"O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory? The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law. But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." -1st Corinthians 15:55-57

"But Herod was outwitted."

2. <u>DESPAIR</u> – *OUT-PLAYED* (v.17-18)

"A voice is heard ... weeping and great mourning ... refusing to be comforted."

"When we sinned, even as our fathers did; we have done wrong and acted wickedly. Yet God saved them for his name's sake, to make his mighty power known." – Psalm 106:6, 8

"Many times God delivered them, but they were bent on rebellion. But he took note of their distress when he heard their cry; for their sake he remembered his covenant and out of his great love he relented." – Psalm 106:43-45

"Restrain your voice from weeping and your eyes from tears, for your work will be rewarded. They will return from the land of the enemy. There is hope for your future. Your children will return to their own land, says the Lord." – Jeremiah 31:16-17

"My feelings are not God. God is God. My feelings do not define truth. God's word defines truth. My feelings are echoes and response to what my mind perceives.
