1. <u>IF YOU FEEL</u> ... <u>ABANDONED</u> – (v.1-2)

"My God, my God, why have your forsaken me?" - v.1a

- "I will never forsake you." Deuteronomy 31:6; Hebrews 13:5
- "Cast all your anxieties upon him, for he cares for you."
 1 Peter 5:7

"Have you felt ... abandoned? Me too." — Jesus

2. <u>IF YOU FEEL</u> ... <u>RIDICULED</u> – (v.6-8)

"I am scorned and despised by the people." – v.6b

- "In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted." 2nd Timothy 3:12
- "I have told you ... in this world you will have trouble." John 16:33a
- "If they persecuted me, they will persecute you." John 15:20

"Have you felt ... ridiculed? Me too." — Jesus

3. <u>IF YOU FEEL</u> ... <u>POWERLESS</u> – (v.14-18)

"My heart has turned to wax; it has melted away within me." -v.14b

- "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." 2 Corinthians 12:9
- "For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are yet was without sin." Hebrews 4:15

4. <u>IF YOU FEEL</u> ... <u>FAR OFF</u> – (v.19-22)

"But you, O Lord, be not far off; O my Strength, come quickly to help me." – v.19
