"OVERCOME" in 1st John - 2:13; 4:4; 5:4a, b; 5

"COMMANDS" – can be very good for you Save, bless, protect, instruct, guide, teach, preserve.

"SIN" – falling short / missing the mark

1. WE HAVE ... AN ADVOCATE – "OURS" (v.1b-2)

"If anyone does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense." – v.1a

• "an atoning sacrifice" –

"God exposes our sin, not to judge us, but by grace to draw us, convict us, forgive us, restore and transform us." – Paul Tripp

2. WE HAVE ... COME TO KNOW GOD – "OBEY" (v.3-4)

"We know that we have come to know him if we obey his commands." – v.3

• "the one who does not ... is a liar" -

1st John 5:3 1st John 3:22, 24

"We are not free to do what is right in our own eyes. We are called to do what is right in His eyes." – R.C. Sproul

3. WE HAVE ... BEEN MADE COMPLETE – LOVE (v.5-6)

"If anyone obeys his word, God's love is truly made complete in him." – v.5a

• "truly made <u>complete</u>" –

1st John 1:4; 2:5; 4:12; 4:17

"This is how we know we are in him: Whoever claims to live in him must walk as Jesus did." – 1st John 5b-6
